On 11.1.2019 while directing that the copy of the paper-book be supplied to learned State counsel, it was also ordered to be heard alongwith COCP No.3938 of 2018. A perusal of COCP No. 3938 of 2018 shows that the same was dismissed in view of the fact that 92 candidates including the petitioner in the said case were directed to come present for physical verification alongwith documents on 28.1.2019 but no one was present on the said date on behalf of the petitioner to confirm as to whether the petitioner was present for his physical verification or not. Similarly, in the present case also, in case the petitioner was not one of the 92 candidates called for interview, the petitioner will be at liberty to revive the contempt petition.

At this stage, the contempt petition is dismissed.
