“Learned counsel for the respondents has handed over the documents pertaining to the case bearing FIR No.142 dated 26.04.2014, under Sections 379, 356 IPC, Police Station, Civil Line, Sonapat to learned counsel for the petitioner who prays for time to go through the same. Be that as it may, this Court may not go into the allegations made against the respondents as the same have already been found to be baseless by the Courts below and even the revision against the same has been dismissed. Learned counsel for the respondent is directed to place on record the said documents.

Adjourned to 16.05.2019.”

Today, in pursuance to the said order, learned counsel for the respondents has placed on record Annexures R-11 and R-12 on record and also handed over the order dated 19.8.2015 passed by the Judicial Magistrate Ist Class, Sonapat on the complaint of the petitioner qua the same allegations as levelled in the present contempt petition, vide which,

the complaint of the petitioner was dismissed. Even the revision against the order and judgment dated 19.8.2015 has been dismissed by the Additional Sessions Judge, Sonapat vide order dated 21.11.2018.
