For cost imposed vide order dated 14.10.2019, cheque amounting to ₹ 2000/- is handed over to the learned counsel for the petitioner and a copy of the receipt is produced in Court amounting to ₹ 8000/- paid to the Poor Patient Welfare Fund, PGIMER.

A reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Shiv Prasad Sharma, Managing Director, The Haryana State Federation of Consumer's Cooperative Wholesale Stores Limited filed in Court annexing communication dated 25.01.2019 is taken on record. A copy of the same is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in view of the communication dated 25.01.2019, no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, seeks liberty to avail remedies in

accordance with law against the said order. It is clarified that this Court has already granted liberty to the petitioner in COCP No. 2757 of 2016.
