Reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Satyapal, HPS, Deputy Superintendent of Police, Rewari has been filed in the Court today. Same is taken on record.

Petitioner-Pinkki has filed this petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of *habeas corpus* directing respondents No.1 to 3 to search for detainee (Maya), who is in illegal custody of respondents No.4 to 9.

Notice of motion was issued.

Learned State counsel put in appearance on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3.

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Today, learned counsel for respondents No.4 and 5 has appeared and filed copy of order dated 13.12.2018 passed in CRWP-945-2018 by a Coordinate Bench of this Court.

Heard.

Earlier, Manoj Kumar has filed the criminal writ petition regarding the same relief which was decided on 13.12.2018. At that time, detenue-Maya was produced in the Court and she stated that she is major and has performed marriage with Prem of her own will. She also stated that she does not want to go in the company of her father-Manoj Kumar (petitioner in that petition). Now, petitioner-Pinkki, who is sister of father of detenue has filed this petition by concealing the material facts. Since the matter has already been decided in the earlier petition regarding *habeas corpus* and statement of detenue has already been recorded, therefore, the present criminal writ petition is dismissed.
