The contempt petitions have been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 18.7.2018 passed in CWP No. 17305 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"In view of the above factual position, this petition, at this stage is being disposed of without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, by giving a direction to respondents to look in to the legal notice dated 08.05.2018 (Annexure P-10) of the petitioners and decide the same in accordance with law, within a period of three months' from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order. However the petitioners are at liberty to approach this Court again if they feel aggrieved by the order passed by the Competent Authority.

Reply filed by way of affidavit of Mr. Maheshwar Sharma, Director, Elementary Education, Haryana, copy supplied to counsel for petitioners. Along

With reply, order dated 12.7.2019/15.7.2019 is annexed, whereby the claim

of the petitioners has been rejected.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that in view of the order passed, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition, however, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
