The present petition has been filed by the petitioners under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to the official respondents No.1 to 5 for protection of their life and liberty at the hands of private respondents No. 6 to 12, as they have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that the petitioners are still having apprehension as they have not been allowed to come to the Court. Nothing has been shown in support of his submission made by the counsel today in Court.

In view of the statements given by the private respondents that they have accepted the marriage of the petitioners, it is apparent that there is no threat to the petitioners. It is further conceded by learned counsel for the petitioners that till today no untoward incident has been taken place.

In view of the aforesaid, no ground for invoking the inherent powers under Section 482 Cr.P.C is made out.
