The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 14.9.2017.

Reply by way of affidavit of Dr. V.K. Shastri, Collector-cum-Deputy Excise and Taxation Commissioner (Excise), Fatehabad dated 15.2.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the reply, the order dated 3.7.2018 was passed even before the filing of the present contempt petition which is placed on record as Annexure R-1.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the said order was never communicated to him, because, in case, it was communicated to him he would not have filed the present contempt petition. Moreover, he was forced to file another writ petition because his accounts were attached in view of the said order, which he has challenged by way of separate writ petition. It is further stated that now he has to challenge the order dated 3.7.2018 by way of filing appeal and the same may be beyond limitation.

Be that as it may, the order having been complied with, this Court does not deem it appropriate to proceed with the present contempt petition, the same is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to take all the pleas before the appropriate Bench challenging the order dated 3.7.2018.
