The petitioner seeks regular bail in case FIR No.63 dated 7.5.2018, registered at Police Station Odhan, District Sirsa, under Sections 22/27-A/61 of NDPS Act, 1985.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner has been in custody for more than 06 months. The trial is not likely to be concluded at an early date as only 02 PWs have been examined till date out of total of 14 PWs. The petitioner does not have any criminal antecedents and therefore, he may be released on regular bail.

Custody certificate dated 18.2.2019, by way of affidavit of Sh. Varun Sinwar, Deputy Superintendent, District Prison, Sirsa, has been filed by the learned State counsel in Court and the same is taken on record. According to this certificate, the petitioner has undergone actual custody of 06 months and 09 days and there are no other criminal cases pending or decided against him.

The factual submissions made by counsel for the petitioner have not been controverted by learned State counsel.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, I

deem it appropriate to allow this petition. Accordingly, the petition is

allowed and petitioner-Salman Khan, is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court concerned.
