The petitioner filed a writ petition being aggrieved of the action of respondents for compulsorily retiring him. The petition was allowed and the order compulsorily retiring the petitioner was set aside, the respondents were directed to extend all consequential benefits including monetary benefits.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that monetary benefits have been paid but the other consequential benefits have not been extended.

Learned counsel for the respondents relies upon an order dated 22.3.2018 whereby the petitioner has been reinstated with all consequential benefits including monetary benefits. It is not forth coming from the said order that in view of the setting aside of the compulsory retirement order and the reinstatement of the petitioner what consequential benefits have been granted.

Let respondents pass a reasoned order with regard to consequential benefits. The order will be passed after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and within three months from today. In case the petitioner is found entitled to consequential benefits, the same shall be extended as expeditiously as possible.
