The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of the order dated 30.03.2017 passed in CWP No. 6316 of 2017.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

“ Accordingly, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to the Competent Authority to decide the claim of the petitioners as set out in the legal notice (P-10) and the present writ petition by passing a speaking order within six months from the receipt of certified copy of the order alongwith the copy of the writ petition. The admissible monetary benefits shall thereafter be released within next three months ”

Pursuant to notice of motion compliance reports were filed annexing order dated 29.03.2019 whereby the claim of the petitioners have been partly accepted.

In view of compliance reports, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that no cause of action survives for pursuing the present contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law for the redressal of grievance.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
