AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 11.05.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.21562 of 2017.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Mr. Avtar Singh, Divisional Engineer, states that payment of ₹26,00,000/- (approximately) is due to the petitioner. He states that payment shall be made to the petitioner within eight weeks from today.

In view of statement made, learned counsel for the petitioner states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the

contempt petition.

The contempt petition is disposed of.

It is made clear that if statement made today in the Court is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. In case he is forced to do so, exemplary costs may be imposed which shall be recoverable from the defaulting officers/officials.
