The learned counsel submits that respondent No.6 Nishan Singh has repeatedly been filing complaints against the petitioners with identical allegations to the effect that the petitioners while holding out a promise to send Nishan Singh's brother abroad had deprived him of huge amount and that although two such applications, one filed in the year 2012 and another filed in the year 2014, had been duly inquired into by police and had been filed but said Nishan Singh has now again moved another application to the police with identical allegations whereupon the petitioners are being unnecessarily harassed.

Having heard the learned counsel for the petitioners, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala to look into the matter and to decide the representation dated 6.12.2018 Annexure P-4, moved by petitioners expeditiously in accordance with law. In case the allegations contained therein are found to be well founded then necessary

steps be taken thereupon as warranted under law. It is further ordered that in case the petitioners are required to be associated with any inquiry or any information is to be elicited from them pertaining to any allegations levelled by Nishan Singh or his brother then a prior written notice be afforded to them before summoning them.

A copy of this order alongwith representation dated 6.12.2018 Annexure P-4 be sent to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, Kapurthala, District Kapurthala so as to enable him to do the needful.
