The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the order dated 23.04.2016 passed by this Court in CWP No. 7317 of 2016. The operative part of the order is reproduced below:

“Accordingly, without commenting on the merits of the case and the entitlement of the petitioner, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent no. 4 to decide the legal notice dated 15.02.2016 (Annexure P-5) within a period of 3 months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order. Needless to say if the relief is to be denied, a reasoned order be passed and conveyed to the petitioner.”

Pursuant to notice of motion, a reply was filed annexing order dated 01.08.2016.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the claim of the petitioner has been partly accepted. He further states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to

avail remedies in accordance with law against the order dated 01.08.2016

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
