The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 10.8.2018, vide which direction was issued to respondent No.2 to deposit a sum of ₹ 74,05,663/-. However, only a sum of ₹49,37,109/- has been made in CALA account vide PIU office letter No.PD/PIU/JAL/2018/Court case/200-A dated 31.12.2018.

Learned counsel for NHAI at this stage, undertakes to deposit the balance amount under protest on the ground that they are likely to challenge the order. Admittedly, the order was passed way back on 10.8.2018 and has not been challenged till date. Be that as it may, the balance amount be deposited within a period of one month from today. Thereafter, the amount shall be disbursed to the petitioner forthwith.

In view of above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, in case, the petitioner is aggrieved in any manner, he is at liberty to revive the present contempt petition.
