Reply by way of affidavit of Mr. D.K. Saldi, District Development and Panchayat Officer, SAS Nagar filed in the Court, is taken on record. Copy handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned State counsel on instructions from Mr. Ranjit Singh Bains, BDPO, Kharar, states that as per paragraph No.6 of the affidavit, warrants of possession would be executed shortly, if there are no legal impediments. She submits that police help would be provided to the DDPO, SAS Nagar for executing warrants of possession and needful would be done within two months. She
