SUDIP AHLUWALIA J. (ORAL)

Ld. counsel for the petitioner submits *inter alia* that the order directing issuance of a conditional warrant of arrest vide the impugned order dated 16.11.2018 against the petitioner-Judgment Debtor was not called for since his objections against the execution had not yet been disposed off. He further submits that now the matter is fixed for the same purpose on 17.01.2019.

In view of the nature of the order, this Court proposes to pass at this stage, no notice need be served upon the respondents-Decree Holders, as that would result to unnecessary delay.

The present petition is, thus, disposed off with a direction upon the Ld. Court below to decide the petitioner's application of objections against the execution preferably on the date fixed i.e. 17.01.2019 or as soon thereafter as practicable without granting any unnecessary adjournment to either side, and that the warrant of arrest

issued against the petitioner vide the impugned order shall not be executed till the final order on the objections filed by him, is passed.
