The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of order dated 21.08.2018, vide which, direction was issued to respondent Nos.2 and 3 to decide petitioner's request for transfer of the house in his favour and decision to the said effect was taken within a period of two months.

Short reply by way of affidavit of respondent No.1 filed in Court is taken on record. The case of the petitioner was considered by way of passing a speaking order dated 01.02.2019, which is placed on record as Annexure R-1. Copy given to learned counsel for the petitioner. As per the said speaking order, the plot can be transferred only after the issuance of N.O.C. and on deposit of non construction fee of ₹12,60,140/-, ₹1,17,500/- and ₹40,019/- on account of enhancements, which comes to total of ₹14,17,650/- in the account of the trust.

Today, learned counsel for the petitioner states that the said amount has been deposited vide receipt No.119512 dated 12.03.2019.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

The respondents shall verify the fact of deposit the said amount and accordingly transfer the plot forthwith as per the speaking order, so passed.
