The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 7.10.2015 passed in CWP No. 21431 of 2015.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

"In view of the above, without going into the merits of the claim of the petitioner, this petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1 to look into the grievance of the petitioner, as contained in representation dated 26.2.2015 (Annexure P-5) and take a decision thereon in accordance with law, expeditiously, preferably, within three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order."

The representation of the petitioner was decided by the General Manager of Oriental Bank of Commerce. The only dispute raised is that the petitioner had an issue with the then General Manager of the Bank who decided the representation.

Both the counsel agree that let a representation be decided afresh by the Executive Director of the Bank in accordance with law after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

Let petitioner remain present in the office of Executive Director
at 11:00 am on 17.9.2019. The representation would be decided
expeditiously but not later than four weeks.
