Petitioners filed a writ petition claiming benefit of incentive increments at 4/9/14 years under the Assured Career Progression Scheme on 03.11.2006. The petition was disposed of on 07.11.2016 with the direction to the Competent Authority to decide the claims of the petitioners as set out in the legal notice and, thereafter, release the admissible monetary benefits within next three months.

The grievance raised in the present petition is that no payments have been made.

During the pendency of the present petition, the payment was made to petitioner No.3. On 02.11.2018, respondents were directed to pay the arrears of other petitioners within a period of six weeks.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from Mr. Kulwinder Singh,

Assistant O/o Chief Engineer, submits that the payments of arrears have been

made to petitioners No.1,2, 4 and 5 and the same have been credited to their respective accounts.

Learned counsel for the petitioners is not in a position to contradict the said fact due to lack of instructions. He raises a grievance that the arrears have been restricted to 38 months without passing any order.

Learned State counsel submits that the arrears have been restricted relying upon the instructions as well as the decision of the Apex Court and a reasoned order would be communicated to the petitioners within six weeks from today.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of.

Needless to add that petitioners would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law if they are aggrieved of the order passed by the Competent Authority for restricting the arrears to 38 months.
