The petitioner has filed present petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. for issuance of a direction to respondents No.1 to 3 to transfer the investigation to the Crime Branch in case FIR No.466 dated 15.11.2018 under Section 120-B and 365 read with Section 34 IPC registered at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage, the petitioner confines his prayer for issuance of a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Nuh to allow the petitioner to meet his daughter, who is in protection home. He further states that for the said relief, the petitioner has already made a representation dated 30.11.2018 (Annexure P-4) to the respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Nuh and at this stage, the petitioner would be satisfied in case a direction is issued to respondent No.3 to consider the said representation.

Notice of motion.

On asking of this Court, Mr. Manish Bansal, Deputy Advocate General, Haryana accepts notice on behalf of official respondents No.1 to 3.

Let requisite number of copies of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Heard.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, but considering the limited prayer of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Nuh to look into the contents of representation dated 30.11.2018 (Annexure P-4) for the limited purpose of meeting his daughter and to act in accordance with law.
