This is a petition filed under Section 439 of the Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No. 54 dated 07.04.2016, under Sections 399/402/148/149 of the Indian Penal Code, registered at Police Station Sadar Amritsar, District Amritsar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that petitioner was arrested on 10.6.2018.

As per the custody certificate dated 22.1.2019 filed in Court today, petitioner is in custody for the last about 07 months and 11 days.

As per the version in the FIR, police received a secret information that six persons are making preparation to commit dacoity. Three persons were apprehended at the spot. On the disclosure statement one of the person was apprehended at the spot. Petitioner was named to be one of the three persons who ran away from the spot.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that vide order dated 19.11.2018, passed by this Court, co-accused namely Love has been granted bail vide *CRM-M-49654-2018* titled as *Love vs. State of Punjab*.

Considering that the disposal of the challan will take time, there is no ground for further detention of the present petitioner. Accordingly, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing personal bonds in the sum of Rs. 50,000/- with one surety of the like amount to the satisfaction of the trial Court subject to following conditions: -

- (1) Petitioner shall surrender his passport before the trial Court, if any, and shall not leave the country without prior intimation to the Court;
- (2) Petitioner shall not directly or indirectly give any inducement or threat or promise to any witness and
- (3) Petitioner shall attend the Court on each and every date of hearing before the trial Court and in case of his absence, trial Court shall be competent to cancel his bail.

Petition stands allowed accordingly.
