Short reply by way of affidavit of Karnesh Sharma, IAS, Director, Department of Local Government Punjab dated 20.2.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the said reply, the order has been complied with by way of passing speaking orders dated 9.1.2018 and 31.1.2019, vide which, relief claimed by the petitioner has been granted.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
