This contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 1.3.2018 passed in CWP No. 4993 of 2018.

The operational part of the order is reproduced below:

" Accordingly, without expressing any opinion on the merits of the case, the direction is issued to the respondent-Director Elementary Education, Panchkula, Haryana to take a decision on all the claims within three months from the date of receiving of the certified copy of the order. The petitioner will be heard, in case an adverse order is proposed to be passed. However, if the claim/s of the petitioner is/are found justified, then he can be given relief/s without passing a speaking order."

Reply along with order has already been filed.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in case any grievance survives the petitioner be given liberty to avail remedy as available.

In view of the order passed by respondent, no cause of action survives for contempt.

Disposed of as infructuous.

The rule issued against respondent is hereby discharged.

However, in case the petitioner is aggrieved of order passed by respondent, he shall be at liberty to take remedy as available in accordance with law.
