Application is disposed of.

Main case

This is a petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of bail in case FIR No. 188, dated 20.7.2018, registered under Section 22 of NDPS Act, under Sections 25, 27, 54 of Arms Act, 1959 and under Section 61 of Punjab Excise Act No. 1 of 1914, at Police Station Talwandi Sabo, District Bathinda.

The allegations against petitioner are that 700 tablets of Clivadol SR-100 MG were recovered from him.

As per FSL report dated 1.10.2018, average weight of these tablets was found to be 358.54 mg. Accordingly, total recovery effected from petitioner is 250 gm 978 mg. The investigation of case is complete and challan has been presented. Petitioner is in custody since 26.7.2018.

Without commenting anything on merit of case and also bearing in mind the fact that petitioner is in custody since 26.7.2018 and

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the trial of the case may take a long time, no useful purpose would be served by keeping him behind bars. Hence, petition is allowed. He is ordered to be released on bail on his furnishing bail and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Trial Court/Duty Magistrate concerned. However, if petitioner indulges in any activity of similar nature, for which he has been convicted, while on bail, prosecution agency will be at liberty to seek cancellation of order granting bail to petitioner.
