Short reply by way of affidavit of Barjinder Singh, Land Acquisition Collector, Jalandhar dated 14.1.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the reply, the order has been complied with by way of passing a speaking order dated 31.12.2018 (Annexure R-1).

Rule issued to the respondents stand discharged.

However, the petitioner is at liberty to challenge the order dated 31.12.2018 in accordance with law, if so aggrieved.
