Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the issue with regard to interest on the delayed payment has not been decided. S/Sh. Hussan Lal, Secretary, PWD, Avikesh Gupta, LAC, N.P. Singh and P.K. Shakir are present in Court in pursuance of order dated 9.10.2019. Learned State counsel on instructions submits that the issue with regard to interest would be considered and decided expeditiously.

Let the petitioner file a detailed representation within one week from today and the respondents shall decide the representation within four weeks from its filing.

Learned State counsel states that respondent No. 2 and 4 would ensure that a detailed order is passed in accordance with law after providing an opportunity of hearing to the petitioner.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

In case the petitioner is found entitled to interest, the same shall be paid within four weeks from the date of decision on the representation.

In case the statement made today in Court is not adhered to, the petitioner would be at liberty to revive the contempt petition. It is, however, clarified that in case the petitioner is aggrieved against the order passed, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedy in accordance with law.
