The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 20.8.2013, vide which, direction was issued that the petitioner would be entitled to interest @ 8% per annum w.e.f. 1.6.2009 till the date of payment and in case the same is not paid within three months from the date of the order, the petitioner would be entitle to claim the same with further interest @ 8% per annum.

Short reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Om Parkash, Senior Medical Officer, PHC, Chakkowal, District Hoshiarpur dated 26.2.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the said reply, the petitioner has been paid interest @ 8% per annum with a further increase of interest @ 8% per annum, as the same was not paid within the stipulated period. Calculation has also been placed on record, vide which, the amount has been deposited in the account of the petitioner.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

In case, if any discrepancy is found in the amount so paid, the petitioner will be at liberty to file representation.
