The writ petition, filed by the petitioner raising the grievance of date of his regularization and that proper pay scale was not being paid. The petition was disposed of on 29.05.2018 with the directions to General Manager, Haryana Roadways, Chandigarh to take decision on legal notice dated 23.12.2017 and pass a speaking order.

In pursuant to notice of motion, reply dated 29.08.2019 was filed. It is pleaded that the legal notice has been considered and pay of the petitioner re-fixed and arrears deposited in his account.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that no formal order has been communicated.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that a reasoned order considering the representation would be passed, if not already passed, within six weeks from today.

In view of the statement of learned counsel for the respondent, the contempt petition is disposed of. In case, the petitioner is aggrieved of the order passed by the respondent, he would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

Rule issued against the respondent is discharged.
