Prayer in this petition filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. is for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in FIR No.57 dated 21.09.2018 under Section 306 IPC, 1860, registered at Police Station Khui Khera, District Fazilka.

Power of attorney filed on behalf of the complainant, is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that apart from the fact that the matter has been compromised between the parties, complainant-Harjit Singh, who is brother of deceased-Shinderpal Kaur has given an affidavit dated 07.12.2018 (Annexure P-2) that the matter has been compromised. He further states that marriage between the petitioner and the

deceased was solemnized in the year, 2008 and it is after 11 years, she has committed suicide.

Learned counsel for the complainant does not dispute the factum of compromise.

Learned State Counsel on instructions from ASI Sharanjit states that the police has verified the compromise so arrived at between the parties.

I have heard learned counsel for the parties.

Without observing anything on merits of the case and considering the fact that the petitioner is in custody since 27.09.2018 and no suicide note has been left by the deceased, the present petition is allowed and the petitioner is admitted on regular bail, subject to furnishing of his bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of trial Court.
