The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that there is wilful disobedience of the interim order dated 27.9.2017 passed in CWP No. 22105 of 2017.

The dispute in the writ petition was with regard to Assured Career Progression to be granted to the petitioner. It is pertinent to note that in the meantime the petitioner has attained the age of superannuation. In the writ petition, it was ordered that recovery shall remain stayed.

The grievance in the contempt petition is that in spite of stay of recovery, certain retiral benefits have not been disbursed.

Learned counsel for the respondent, on instructions from Sh. Arun Munjal, Executive Engineer, Irrigation Department, Rohtak submits that no recovery is being made and only the payment has not been

made to await the outcome of the writ petition.

To resolve the controversy, learned counsel for the parties are *ad idem* that let the amount be deposited in a nationalised bank in shape of FDR fetching maximum rate of rate subject to outcome of the writ petition.

Ordered accordingly.

The needful be done within four weeks.

The contempt petition is disposed of.
