The present petition has been filed under Section 10 and 12 of the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 (for short, 'the Act 1971') for the alleged wilful and deliberate disobedience of the Order dated 16.3.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No. 29823 of 2017.

Learned counsel for the respondent has filed a short reply along with Annexure-R1, i.e. order dated 25.5.2018 deciding the representation submitted by the petitioner, which is taken on record.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the order of this Court has been complied with and the representation has been decided but petitioner may be granted liberty to challenge the same if aggrieved.

Disposed of as having been rendered infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

Needless to add that the petitioner can avail his remedy against the order Annexure R1 in accordance with law.
