The present petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing respondents not to allow the allottees to transfer or alienate the plots allotted to them by the respondent-HUDA pursuant to a draw of lots held on 23.03.2004.

The claim of the petitioner is that there was a bungling in the allotment of plots in the oustees category regarding which he has already moved a complaint/representation dated 21.05.2018(AnnexureP-2). However, the same has not been decided by respondent No.2.

Therefore, without commenting on the merits of the controversy, we dispose of the writ petition with a direction to respondent No.2 to decide the representation (Annexure P-2) of the petitioner forthwith.
