The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 13.3.2018.

Short reply by way of affidavit of A. Venu Prasad, IAS, Principal Secretary, Department of Local Government, Punjab dated 24.4.2019 filed in Court is taken on record. As per the same, the order has been complied with by way of passing a speaking order dated 14.1.2019 (Annexure R-1). It is evident from Annexure R-2 that total amount of ₹ 15,59,418/- has been paid towards the retiral benefits, but interest is yet to be paid to the petitioner as per the decision taken vide Annexure R-1.

Sh. Tarun Kumar, EO, MC, Goniana is present in Court and states that the interest shall also be paid within eight weeks.

In view of the above, the present contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.

In case, the interest is not paid within eight weeks, the

petitioner is at liberty to revive the present contempt petition. Further, in

case, if there is any discrepancy in the amount so paid, the petitioner is at liberty to file representation, which shall be decided in accordance with law.
