AVNEESH JHINGAN, J (Oral):

The present contempt petition has been filed pleading wilful disobedience of order dated 03.07.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.12273 of 2016.

The relevant portion of the order is reproduced as under:-

“Hence, this petition is disposed of by giving direction to the respondents to release the revised pensionary benefits after counting adhoc service as qualifying service to the petitioners within a period of six weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.”

Reply by way of affidavit of Dr. Gulshan Lal Taneja, Registrar, Maharshi Dayanand University, Rohtak has been filed

today in the Court, same is taken on record. Copy of reply is handed over to learned counsel for the petitioners.

Learned counsel for the respondents states that payments of revised pensionary benefits have been released to the petitioners.

In view of reply filed and statement made, learned counsel for the petitioners states that no cause of action survives for pursuing the contempt petition. However, he seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law, if aggrieved of calculation of the amount.

The contempt petition is disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

The rule issued against the respondents stands discharged.
