The writ petition filed by the petitioner challenging his dismissal of the service was allowed. The impugned orders endorsed on 27.10.2008 and order dated 11.10.2010 were quashed. It was directed that the arrears be released to the petitioner within two months from the date of receipt of certified copy of the order, along with interest at the rate of 9% per annum.

The present contempt petition has been filed alleging wilful disobedience of the directions of this Court passed in CWP No. 991 of 2011, as no arrears and interest has been paid.

Pursuant to notice of motion, reply by way of affidavit of Sh. Parveen Kumar Sinha, Additional Director General of Police, Prisons, Punjab, Chandigarh filed in Court is taken on record. Along with the reply,

the detailed calculation sheets have been annexed. A copy of reply is

handed over to learned counsel for the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the respondents submits that arrears found due to the petitioner have been paid. She submits that the interest amounting to Rs. 3116/- and 46744/- was credited in the bank account of the petitioner on 27.09.2019.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the amount of the arrears were not correctly calculated and even the interest has also been not properly worked out.

The grievance raised by the learned counsel for the petitioner does not fall within the ambit of the present contempt petition.

In view of the above, the contempt petition is disposed of.

However, the petitioner would be at liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law for redressal of surviving grievances, if any.

Rule issued against respondent is discharged.
