The grievance raised by the petitioners in this writ petition is that the respondents be restrained from transferring the management of the plots from HUDA Department to HSIIDC. The apprehension of the petitioners is that if this is done, they would be subjected to terms and conditions that may be at variance with the ones offered to them by HUDA.

After hearing the learned counsel for the petitioners, we are of the opinion that the grievance of the petitioners is based on an apprehension. Merely because HUDA will hand over the management to HSIIDC should not be viewed as a cause of concern unless some prejudice manifests itself. The apprehension expressed by the petitioners does not manifest itself from any document on record. We, therefore, decline interference at this stage but leave it open to the petitioners to raise the issue if original terms and conditions of the allotment etc. are varied to their disadvantage.

Petition dismissed.
