The petitioner filed a writ petition seeking directions to the respondents to re-check the answer-sheet by evaluating the answers to question Nos. 2 and 14. The writ petition was disposed of on 03.03.2015 directing respondent No. 2 (in the writ petition) to re-check the answer-sheet particularly for questions No. 2 and 14.

The present contempt petition is filed pleading that the needful has not been done by the respondents.

In the affidavit dated 08.03.2019 filed it has been specifically pleaded that the answer-sheets have been rechecked.

Learned counsel for the petitioner raises a grievance that the re-checking has not been done in a proper manner. However, seeks liberty to avail remedies in accordance with law.

In view of the above, as there is substantial compliance of the directions of this Court, no interference is called for in the present contempt proceedings. The contempt petition is disposed of with liberty as prayed for.

Rule issued against the respondents is discharged.
