The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 27.7.2016, vide which, direction was issued to Senior Superintendent of Police, Bathinda to take appropriate action in accordance with law, if some substance is found in the representation of the petitioner.

This Court may note that no one appeared for the petitioner, when the matter was listed on 27.2.2017 and 3.4.2017. Thereafter, on 4.5.2017, learned counsel appearing for the petitioner took time and it was listed on 12.7.2017. On 12.7.2017, again no one was present. Finally notice of motion was issued on 4.8.2017 after the counsel for the petitioner chose to appear. Thereafter, on 2.11.2017 and 7.8.2018, the matter was again adjourned as the process fee was not filed by learned counsel for the petitioner. The notice was issued after filing of the process fee. On 3.12.2018, notice issued to the respondent was received back unserved as the respondent was transferred to Chandigarh. Accordingly, the matter was adjourned to 31.1.2019. On 31.1.2019, again counsel for the petitioner was not present. Even appropriate application for impleading the appropriate

moved.

Today, request for an adjournment has been made. It is obvious that the petitioner is not interested to pursue the matter.

Dismissed accordingly.

Rule issued against the respondent stands discharged.
