On hearing parties represented by their respective counsel, this company petition is disposed of in terms of the compromise deed dated 21.03.2016 (Annex R-3) signed by the parties to the dispute, whereby the petitioner has received a sum of Rs.50 lakhs from the respondent in full & final settlement of the dispute. It is also agreed that when the amount is paid, as agreed, parties will withdraw all the criminal complaints filed against each other and any other litigation pending between them on the same subject matter and cause of action. It is not disputed that money has been paid and the compromise deed has been performed in substantial part and what remains is the criminal complaints etc. between the parties. Accordingly, parties are directed to apply to the various Courts/authorities to withdraw those actions and the trial Court will act in aid of this order and dispose of those cases as compromised. It is made clear that no court

henceforth will entertain any application/petition/suit etc. between the parties on the same subject matter settled ad idem.
