The present contempt petition has been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 13.08.2012 vide which status quo regarding possession, as on date was ordered.

Admittedly, on that day, the possession was with the receiver and the receiver has since been removed by way of an order dated 22.11.2018 passed by this Court. The petitioner is not aggrieved with the removal of the receiver. Hence, no contempt can be said to be made out. At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner, however, submitted that he may be allowed to withdraw the present contempt petition with liberty to avail remedy as available to him, in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.
