Learned counsel for the respondents has produced order dated 26.7.2019 wherein it has been stated that the petitioner had received half salary for 66 days which is much more than her entitlement.

Learned counsel for the respondent submits that even the interest issue has been taken care of with the excess payment.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in view of order produced, no cause of action survives for pursuing the present petition, he seeks liberty to move a representation to the respondents in case there is any grievance with regard to calculation of amount.

Disposed of as infructuous with liberty as prayed for.

In case such a representation is made, respondents shall consider the same in accordance with law as expeditiously as possible.
