RAJIV NARAIN RAINA, J. (ORAL):

On 12.07.2018, learned counsel for the petitioner had taken time to file replication. None has been filed. Filing of replication appears to be a ruse to delay the proceedings going on since May 26, 2017. The conduct of the petitioner indicates that he is not interested in prosecuting the petition for winding up by act of non-appearance.

The petition is accordingly dismissed for want of appearance and prosecution. Registry will not entertain any application in this disposed of matter unless the petitioner deposits a sum of Rs.1 lakh in the common pool fund account maintained by the Official Liquidator, even though, the company has not been ordered to be wound up and Official Liquidator has no role to play, at this stage. Proof of payment be produced in the Registry.
