Prayer in this petition filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.68 dated 11.04.2016 registered under Sections 406/498-A of IPC at Police Station City, Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that in the aforesaid FIR, petitioner is an accused as husband. He continued to appear before the trial Court, but on account of his absence on 01.12.2018, his bail bonds were cancelled. The petitioner could not appear before the trial Court on the relevant date on account of his ill-health i.e. backache. However, now he is ready to appear before the trial Court and furnish an undertaking that he shall continue to appear before the trial Court.

Notice of motion.

At the asking of the Court, Mr. Jagmohan Ghumman, DAG,

Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-State.

Let a copy of paper book be given to learned State counsel during the course of the day.

Without observing anything on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction that in case the petitioner appears before the trial Court within a week from today and furnishes an undertaking that he shall not absent himself before the trial Court without prior permission of the Court, he shall be admitted on bail subject to his furnishing adequate bail bonds/surety bonds to the satisfaction of the trial Court, however, that would be subject to payment of costs of Rs.10,000/- to be deposited with the Poor Patients' Welfare Fund of the Postgraduate Institute of Medical Education and Research (PGIMER), Chandigarh.
