HARSIMRAN SINGH SETHI, J

The present writ petition has been filed seeking the benefit as allowed by the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India while deciding Civil Appeal No. 1298 of 2018 on 30.01.2018.

Counsel for the petitioners contends that petitioner No.1 and legal heirs of petitioners No. 2 and 3 are entitled for the benefit under the said judgment but the same is not being extended to them without any justifiable reason.

Learned counsel for the petitioners states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, petitioner No1 and legal heirs of petitioners No. 2 and 3 have served the respondent(s) with a legal notice dated 10.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) and they will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is given to respondents to decide the same.

In view of the above, the present writ petition is disposed of with a direction to the respondents to pass an appropriate order on the legal notice dated 10.12.2018 (Annexure P-5) within a period of three months from the receipt of certified copy of this order.
