Counsel for the petitioner further states that for the relief which has been claimed in the present writ petition, the petitioner has submitted a detailed representation (Annexure P9) to the respondent(s) on 29.09.2017 and the petitioner will be satisfied, at this stage, in case, a time bound direction is given to respondent(s) to decide the same.

At this stage, Mr. B.S.Jaswal, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent-U.T.Chandigarh.

Counsel for U.T.Chandigarh, states that he has no objection with regard to the prayer made by the petitioner for deciding his representation dated 29.09.2017 (Annexure P9) in a time bound manner.
