This petition has been filed under Section 439 Cr.P.C. for grant of regular bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.624 dated 24.09.2018 registered under Section 20 of the N.D.P.S. Act at Police Station Samalkha, District Panipat.

The alleged recovery is stated to be 4 kgs of ganja which is a non-commercial quantity. Counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner has been in custody since 24.09.2018 .

Learned Deputy Advocate General on instructions from ASI Fateh Singh states that the petitioner is also an accused in another similar case but has accepted the fact that in that case also the recovery was of non-commercial quantity and the petitioner is on bail in that case.

Keeping in view the entire conspectus of facts and the period of incarceration already suffered by the petitioner, without going into the

merits of the case, I deem it appropriate to grant regular bail to the petitioner. Ordered accordingly. Bail to the satisfaction of the concerned C.J.M./Illaqa Magistrate/Duty Magistrate.

Petition stands allowed.

Since the main case has been decided, the pending criminal miscellaneous application, if any, also stands disposed of.
