The present contempt petition is filed for non-compliance of the order dated 21.12.2015 vide which a direction was issued to the respondents to decide and consider the claim of the petitioner and in case it is decided to allot the plot to the petitioner, the same shall be made on the current allotment price and not at the old rates.

Reply has been filed. As per the same, the petitioner has been held entitled but the same cannot be allotted in view of the pending enquiry as is evident from Annexure R-1.

In view of the same, this Court cannot say that there is willful contempt. The contempt petition is dismissed.

Rule issued against the respondent(s) stands discharged.

However, in case the petitioner is still not allotted the plot inspite of enquiry being completed and no other impediment in the way, the petitioner shall file the contempt petition.
