Main cases

This order will dispose of a bunch of contempt petitions bearing COCP Nos.597, 656 to 658, 692 to 694, 697 to 699, 747, 748, 733, 749 and 734 of 2018, as common questions of law and facts are involved therein.

The present contempt petitions have been filed for non-compliance of the order dated 6.5.2015, vide which, direction was issued to the State to release the due Grant in Aid to the petitioner-Colleges in CWP No.17086 of 2014 and 16 other connected petitions as per the Rules.

A number of contempt petitions have been filed by the management of colleges. In those contempt petitions, a direction has already been issued by this Court to comply with the order dated 6.5.2015.

The present contempt petitions have been filed by the employees of these colleges. Admittedly, they were not party in the writ petitions. It is also admitted by learned counsel for the petitioner(s) that they have already been paid @ 8% of the salary. Whether they are entitled to @ 10% of the salary or not, has not been adjudicated in the case of the petitioner(s).

In view of the above, learned counsel for the petitioner(s) states that he may be permitted to withdraw the present contempt petitions to enable him to file writ petition seeking the relief or seek any other remedy as available to him in accordance with law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with liberty as prayed for.

Rules issued against the respondents stands discharged.
