The present contempt petition has been filed pleading that the order dated 06.09.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 20129 of 2017 has not been complied with. The operational part of the order is reproduced below:-

“4. Instant petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Chief Engineer (North), Department of Water Supply & Sanitation Head Office, The Mall, Patiala to look into the grievances unfolded by the petitioner in his Legal Notice dated February 03, 2017 (Annexure P-4) and take a conscious decision by passing a speaking order that too, after giving a patience hearing to the petitioner within a period of three months from the date of receipt of a certified copy of this order.

5. However, if petitioner still feels aggrieved by any order of the afore-said authority, he shall be at liberty to approach this Court.”

Learned State counsel has filed the reply along-with Annexure R-1 i.e. the order dated 03.10.2018 passed by the Chief Engineer (South), Deptt. of Water Supply and Sanitation, Nabha Road, Patiala in compliance of the order dated 06.09.2017 passed by this Court in CWP No. 20129 of 2017.

In view of reply, it is evident that the claim of the petitioner has been accepted and the petitioner is found to be entitled to the benefit(s) as claimed through the writ petition.

Since the order of this Court has been complied with, no grievance survives and the present petition has been rendered infructuous.

There is no doubt that the benefits, to which petitioner is found to be entitled, shall be released to him expeditiously.
