1. Learned counsel states that the petitioner has moved an application for interim injunction and the same is listed for 06.02.2019 before the learned Addl. Civil Judge (Senior Division), Assandh. However, the respondents are in the process of installing poles for laying of electricity wires and in case the application is not decided expeditiously, then the suit filed by the petitioner would become infructuous.

2. Learned counsel states that the petitioner would be satisfied if the revision petition is disposed of by directing the learned trial Court to decide the application for interim injunction on the date fixed i.e. 06.02.2019 itself.

3. Having considered the innocuous prayer of the petitioner, I deem it appropriate to dispose of the revision petition by directing the learned trial Court to consider and decide the application for interim

injunction on the date fixed i.e. 06.02.2019 or on any other date shortly thereafter.

4. Revision petition is disposed of in the aforementioned terms.
